## **URBAN ROAD SAFETY PROGRAM**

As part of Main Roads' Urban Road Safety Program, the Town will be delivering a number of simple, low-cost road safety upgrades to key streets across Carlisle, Victoria Park and East Victoria Park.


Under the program, two local roads in your area have been selected to be upgraded with speed hump plateaus, which are designed to reduce vehicle speeds and discourage non-local through traffic. Importantly, speed hump plateaus don't require any kerb modifications or road widening, so they can be constructed quickly with minimal disruption.

Four total speed hump plateaus are proposed to be installed in East Victoria Park – two on Swansea Street (one near 19 Swansea and one near 36 Swansea) and two on Hubert Street (one near 111 Hubert and one near 138 Hubert).

The locations of the plateaus are shown below, along with examples of an existing treatment in a similar urban setting. At this stage, the Town expects construction to commence in mid-2023, however timeframes are subject to change and the Town will keep all affected residents informed about any upcoming works.
