# **Bush Tucker Pack**

height: 0.5m



#### Billardiera fusiformis

Australian Bluebell

height: 0.5m



#### Dioscorea hastiflolia

Warrine

height: 3m



Related to the European parsley, this plant adds a peppery flavour to any dish harvesting the leaves and stems. The sea parsley grows well in sandy and salt tollerant conditions.

The blue bell shaped flowers are in bloom from Jan - Feb and Oct - Dec. A low rambling plant, it can can be trained up a fence or structure.

A perennial climber growing to 3m long with yellow flowers from April - July. A bushtucker species with edible long thin tubers that can be eaten raw or lightly roasted with butter and a pinch of salt.

### **Enchylaena tomentosa**

Ruby Saltbush

height: 0.6m



Succulent short needle like leaves, the shrub has a spreading habit forming small eddible berries all year round.

## Platysace deflexa

Youlk

height: 0.5m



Tuberous perennial herb or shrub growing up to 0.5m high. White flowers in bloom from Jan to Dec. Tuberous roots can be harvested with taste similar to a carrot and sweet eucalypt flavour.

### Tetragonia tetragonoides

Warrigal Greens

height: 0.5m



A compact native ground cover with lush green leaves and small yellow flowes spreading up to 2m. The leaves are a popular alternative to spinach, preparing them by blanching the leaves for 3-4min and discarding the water.
