

Tips

- Select larger pots eg 175mm-200mm for smaller verges, and smaller pots eg 140mm and tubestock for larger verges eg: corner blocks.
- Plant spacing is the distance plants should be planted apart, and relates to the
 mature width or spread of each plant species which is usually stated on the plant
 tag. Plant with some overlap to eliminate gaps where weeds can grow through eg:
 The plant below grows to 1.5m width, space these plants 1-1.2m apart, or for higher
 density planting at 0.7m spacing.
