URBAN ROAD SAFETY PROGRAM

As part of Main Roads' Urban Road Safety Program, the Town will be delivering a number of simple, low-cost road safety upgrades to key streets across Carlisle, Victoria Park and East Victoria Park.

Under the program, six intersections in your area have been selected to be upgraded with mini roundabouts or raised platforms, which are proven traffic calming measures that reduce speed and crash severity. Importantly, both treatments can be constructed with minimal disruption and won't require any kerb modification or road widening works.

Mini roundabouts are proposed at the intersections of Washington/Mackie and Mackie/Gloucester, and raised platforms are proposed at the intersections of Leonard/Washington, Leonard/Gloucester, Cargill/Gloucester and Cargill/Washington.

The locations of the mini roundabouts and raised platforms are shown below, along with examples of existing treatments in similar urban settings. At this stage, the Town expects construction to commence in mid-2023, however timeframes are subject to change and the Town will keep all affected residents informed about any upcoming works.
