














Stadium Ground Floor Plan



Stadium Second Floor Plan




Indoor Centre - Ground Floor Plan



What does it mean for Town of Victoria Park and clubs?

- Further information on operational model and engagement with clubs will continue over the next 12 months.
- This will include approach to commercial arrangements.
- ☐ Key benefits include:
 - No capital expenditure.
 - Increased pitch access and improved rostering.
 - Identity for home clubs in changerooms and function areas.
 - Access to quality function areas.
 - Dedicated equipment storage areas.
 - Increased access to training time, all home fixtures played at Australian Hockey Centre.
 - Enhanced access to indoor hockey options.

Operational Model

- Asset will be owned by VenuesWest.
- Operations will be the responsibility of Hockey WA.
- Facility management model between VenuesWest and Hockey WA is still to be confirmed.
- \square Agreement on model and key terms to occur in next 6 12 months.
- Final agreement not expected to be finalised until December 2026.





Hockey WA – Competition Structure

- In 2025, Hockey WA have improved coordination of club days at Perth Hockey Stadium.
 - Further improvements likely in 2026.
- From 2029, with four turfs fully functional, there will be greater opportunity for significantly easier fixturing to meet the needs of clubs.
- Likely that all three home clubs will have a combination of Friday, Saturday and Sunday club days where they will be the primary user of the venue (Juniors through to seniors).
- The four turf surfaces will mean fewer late fixtures, allowing greater opportunity for club activity.
