 continuing reconciliation journey, the local Noongar population are meaningfully engaged in ways
 that are culturally appropriate.

- Noted that a normal Citizenship Ceremony will still be held on 26 January, as mandated by the Federal Government. This will be held upstairs in the Makuru Room, instead of being held outdoors in Memorial Park.
