

Dear Karen Vernon, Mayor of The Town of Victoria Park,

I am writing to you on behalf of the members of our club, Victoria Park Soccer Club Inc regarding the lighting facilities at Harold Rossiter Park.

We are honoured to be the primary winter user of this beautiful and much loved facility. We acknowledge and celebrate that this park is enjoyed by a range of people, clubs and community groups day and night all year round.

Modern good quality amenity for this active use space including lighting provides a broad benefit to the Town of Victoria Park (ToVP) residents and visitors providing sustainable and well utilised facilities.

If the ToVP were to upgrade floodlighting at this park, it will provide the following direct benefits to our club and members:

- Winter training for all members, junior and senior at the one ground; removing confusion, inefficiency and disconnection of members and volunteers from being spread across 2 locations (these being Harold Rossiter Park and Parnham Park).
- Occasional evening games, to make up for normal rounds unable to be completed due to poor weather conditions or other reasons.
- Safety and security in and around the park between the pitch and clubrooms and entering/exiting the park.

In addition to the benefits to our club, upgraded floodlighting may provide some of the following benefits for other park users and the wider ToVP community:

- Ability to use the park for training, dog walking, exercise, outside daylight hours, or barbeques or playground into early evening.
- Support events held by the Town of Victoria Park such as concert series, or other public events.
- Safety and security for residents walking through the park, presently unlit path adjacent school and other areas.
- Free up use of Parnham Reserve, for other sporting and community groups to take lead use of the venue. The Harold Rossiter EOI was responded to by three clubs, demonstrating a need for football (soccer) space in the Town.

We **enclose** for your attention and submission at the next ordinary council meeting, to be held on 16 March 2021, a petition to the ToVP concerning upgrading the lighting facilities at Harold Rossiter Park for the reasons set out above.

We would greatly appreciate your assistance with this matter and advice relating to the outcome of the enclosed petition.
