Summary	The Perth Demons have at times utilised the ITH during the course of the reporting period.
	During October to December, the Indoor Training Hall was again utilised hosting the WA Blind AFL Competition in collaboration with the WA All Abilities Football Association.
	There is currently the WCE AFL men's, AFL women's, WAFL, Naitanui Academy (indigenous and multicultural players) and Women's & Girls Academy squads training out of MRP all of which utilise the indoor training hall and gym as part of their training sessions. These training sessions occur on every day of the week with the indoor training hall and gym used by each of these squads for training sessions warm up prior to heading onto the ovals and then cool down following, rehabilitation as well as game plan strategy walk-through meetings.
	In addition to these training sessions, specialist maintenance and servicing of the synthetic turf within the indoor training hall is also scheduled on a monthly basis. 	Community Groups who have made use of Oval 2 include Waalitj Foundation's Ken Wyatt Cup, Fit 4 Work and Waalitj Club sessions, WA Football Commission 'Girls Come and Try Event', Integrated Football and WA All Abilities Footy, Ursula Frayne Catholic College interschool games, Vic Park Pigs AFL Masters FC (men's 35+ competition), , and the ToVP, Carlisle and Victoria Park AFLW Masters Inc and Vic Park Raiders (Friday night games under lights). The WCE Walking Footy Program continues to be held weekly and the Lathlain Primary School again held their sports carnival and running events in 2023.

If there are any sections of the Oval 2 playing surface not suitable for use the turf contractor will advise WCE, recommend an approach to repair and then rope the area off till returned to a suitable condition.</li> <li>The annual maintenance program was undertaken in 2023 from mid-September to mid-November on Oval 2 whereby access was not permitted by any parties for .</li> <li>The condition of the Oval 2 playing surface has responded well to the annual maintenance program during the reporting period with both the Perth Demons and WCE recommencing training on the oval.</li> </ul>

	the advice and recommendation of the appointed full time turf contractor to ensure Oval 2 is maintained to the prescribed Oval Areas Standard. This is identified with
	temporary roped off areas within Oval 2.
	During the reporting period the goal squares at both ends of Oval 2 had periods of being unavailable due to heavy use by the general public, Perth Demons and WCE.
	These periods of unavailability were required to return the turf to the required
	standard and was roped off for a period of only approximately 2 weeks.
