The requested funding is for training balls. Each year the club needs to replace half of their training balls due to wear and tear and loss.

Each team needs to start the year with 20 balls and with currently 14 teams as well as Auskick, the club needs 200+ balls to start the season.

Panel Assessment:

- The Victoria Park Junior Football Club claim to be an inclusive and connected community and allowing balls to be purchased through the grant allows the Club to keep the fees down.
- Highly Recommended funding.
- Fairly straightforward replacement of equipment due to wear and tear.
- Recommend for this grant application to be approved as it provides support to one of the communities junior sporting clubs. This grant will also allow for some reduction in player fees as the grant would assist with the expenditure necessary for purchase of equipment.
