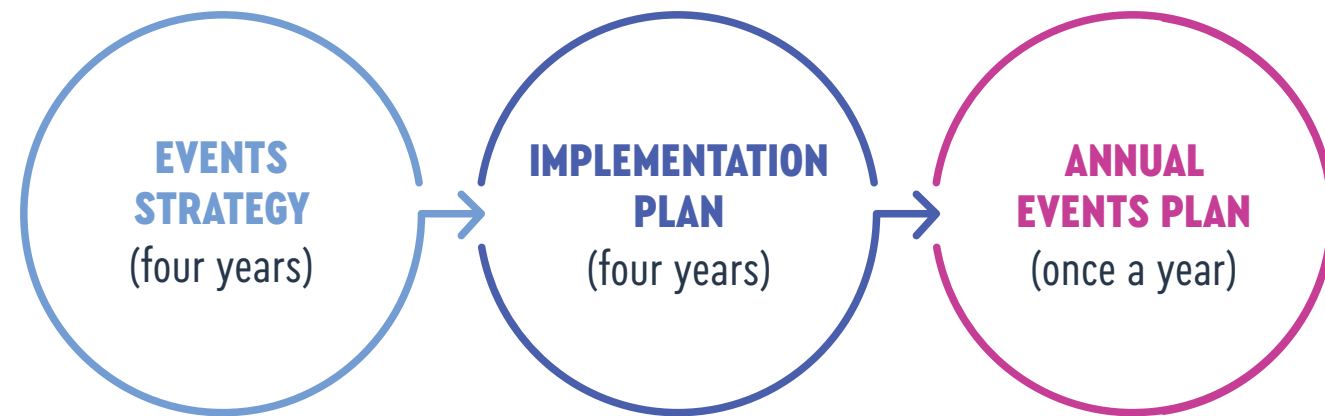

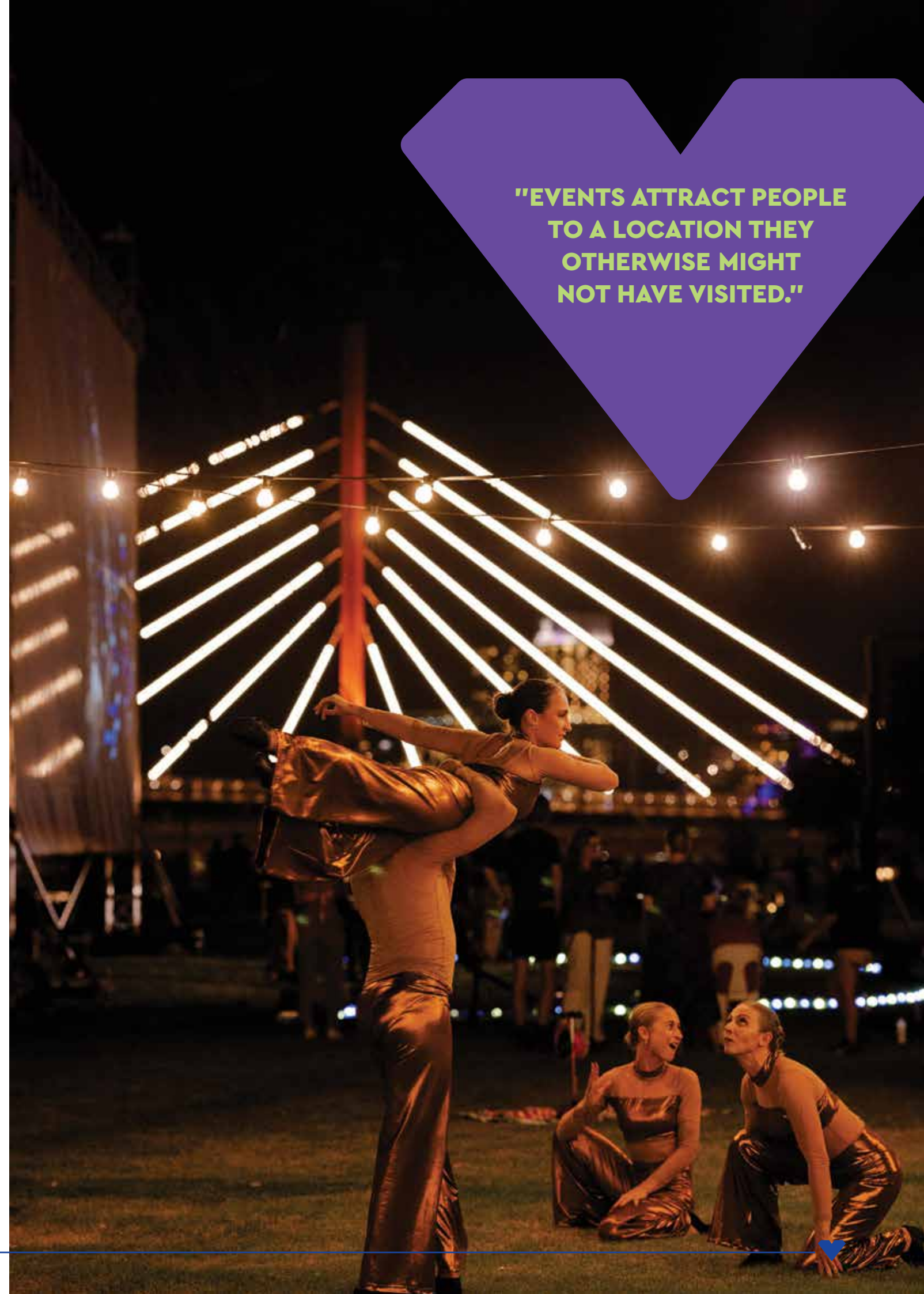

The Town of Victoria Park is proud to present a diverse, inclusive, and community-driven calendar of events and commemorations for the 2025–2026 financial year.

This plan reflects our commitment to delivering, supporting, and promoting a vibrant suite of events that enhance community wellbeing, celebrate culture, and support our local economy—aligned with the Town's Events Strategy and Strategic Community Plan.
