# CCTV Partnership Program 2023-24 Scorecard

By offering rebates to people who install CCTV within the Town of Victoria Park, we increase the number of CCTV systems in strategic locations, assist WA Police with investigations, improve the detection of criminal activity and contribute to helping people feel safe (S1).

#### What did we do?

- Processed and approved 66 funding applications.
- Distributed \$45,660 grant funding.
- Added wireless cameras to the CCTV Partnership Program, resulting in a more affordable option for community members.

#### How well did we do it?

- ToVP has the most registered systems on Cam-Map WA out of any LGA, helping WA Police to investigate incidents.
- 51% budget distributed among 66 households.
- 53% participants provided footage to WA Police.
- 56% participants used their systems to assist neighbours.
- 90% found the application process easy to use.

#### Who benefited?

- Town of Victoria Park residents.
- Town of Victoria Park businesses.
- Town of Victoria Park community groups.
- WA Police.
