Rough brown linear bark with slender green leaves. Clusters of white, nectar-filled flowers during spring and summer attract bees and birds.

Grey to grey-brown bark which sheds in short ribbons. Narrow lanceolate leaves are soft grey-green in colour.



Common name: Red flowering iron bark

Very dark brown to black bark. The dramatic bark colour forms a great backdrop to the lanceolate greygreen foliage. Flowers are produced from winter to early spring, creamy to pink and red in colour.



A medium to small tree flowering between Aug–Dec with clusters of pink-red blooms. A species from the Eastern Goldfields is a hardy species for Perth.

The trunk of the tree is usually straight with smooth bark. Clusters of flower buds bloom through the months of Dec-May.

Common name: Jacaranda

A deciduous tree with soft fine green foilage turning yellow before shedding. Large clusters of purple bell-shaped flowers form in summer before the leaves, flowers are followed by curved disk seed pods.





Common name: Broad leaved paperbark

**Botanical name:** Melaleuca viridiflora

Papery layered bark, grey to cream in colour. Dark green leaves oval in shape. Flowers are bottlebrush like, red/crimson in colour. Flowering Sept-March. Well suited to low lying areas inundated with seasonal water.

Small dark green oval-shaped foliage with serrated edges. Deciduous, with mottled flaky bark varying in colour between brown, reddish brown, dark grey and cream.
