How much did we do?

6 events

4 partnerships

50 attendees at the flag raising event

40 attendees at the Drag Storytime Lunch n Learn

150 attendees at the outdoor movie night

Pride banners on display for 30 days

It was a great initiative to raise awareness of people's differences.

It was so great to hear personal experiences and learning on being an ally for the LGBTQIA+ community.

How well did we do it?

94% attendees said that events increased their feelings of inclusion

93% said that events made them feel safe and welcome

89% said that events increased their sense of belonging

85% said that events increased their feelings of wellbeing

82% said they learnt something new
