How well did we do it?

**90%** of attendees said the event made them feel safe and welcome

**77%** said that it had a positive effect on their physical health and mental wellbeing

**75%** said they learnt something new

**74%** said they gained new insight or knowledge

# Who benefited?

Town of Victoria Park residents, including:

People born overseas (50%)

People who speak a language other than English at home (30%)

LGBTQIA+ people (10%)

People with disability (10%)
