...across **94** households



...resulting in **86%** of funding recipients feeling safer*



...to subsidise installation of **220** security devices

Security Incentive Scheme Scorecard

By incentivising community to install security devices, we reduce opportunities for crime and contribute to helping people feel safe (S1).

How much did we do?

\$37,193 funding provided

94 rebates granted

220 devices installed

86% of recipients felt safe or very safe after installing a subsidised security device, an **increase of 56%**

3% of people still feel unsafe after installing a subsidised security device, an **improvement of 25%**
